CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

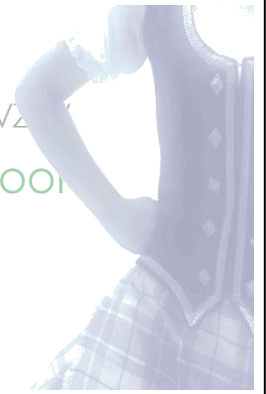
- Combinations and divisions according to the number of entries in the age-categories

- Aggregate "Most Points" Trophy awarded in each age group over all dances, except Primary
- "Most Promising Beginner" Award, selected by the Adjudicator
- Perpetual Trophies to remain in Europe
- Dancers must be in Highland costume, including dance shoes, to receive awards
