Directions to Cleveden Secondary School

Traveling by Car

From the WEST – approaching via Anniesland Cross, follow signs for City Centre. Travel along Great Western Road towards Glasgow. Continue on the road passing Gartnavel Hospital. At the traffic lights **after** the hospital TURN LEFT on to Cleveden Road.

Continue up the road, straight through the double roundabout, the school is on the right hand side.

From the EAST – From Glasgow, take Great Western Road. Continue on the road past the Botanic Gardens. At the second set of traffic lights sign posted Nuffield Hospital etc TURN RIGHT on to Cleveden Road (Hotel du Vin sits on the corner). Follow directions as detailed above.

LARKHALL to KELVINDALE – this is the stations nearest to the school, except there is a rather steep hill to climb from the station.

Awards

Medals will be awarded in all dances of all sections above.

Overall trophy and **Runner-up** trophy awarded to the dancers with the highest number of points over dances 3, 4, 5 and 6 in Beginners and Novice age groups.

Dancer of the Day Trophy

Trophy awarded to the Beginner and Novice dancer with the highest number of points over 6 dances (excluding Trophy Fling). There must be at least 6 dancers in the age group to qualify.

Commencing 1.00pm – (Starting with Events 8 and 9)

Intermediate: Dances – 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10 and *11 **OR** *12 (maximum of 8 dances)

- 6 years and under 10 years
- 10 years and under 13 years
- 13 years and over

Premier: Dances – 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10 and *11 **OR** *12 (maximum of 8 dances)

- 7 years and under 10 years
- 10 years and under 12 years
- 12 years and under 14 years
- 14 years and under 16 years
- 16 years and over

Note: Dancers must choose either event *11 **or** *12 Steps – (4) all dances except Swords (2 & 1)

Awards

Medals will be awarded in all dances of all sections for Intermediate and Premier.

Highland trophy and runner-up trophy awarded to the dancers with the highest number of points over the 4 highland dances.

National trophy awarded to dancer with highest number of points over events 8, 9 and 10. Keeper trophy awarded for events 11 and 12.

Dancer of the Day Trophy

Trophy awarded to the Intermediate and Premier dancer with the highest number of points over the 7 dances. There must be at least 6 dancers in the age group to qualify.

The organiser reserves the right to alter or amalgamate age groups.

The judges' decision is **FINAL**.
