- Combinations and divisions according to the number of entries in the age-categories
- All competitors are to show **on-site** their current S.O.B.H.D. registration cards
- Competitors should abide by the rules and standards of the S.O.B.H.D.
- Competitors' ages will be taken as on the date of the competition
- The adjudicator's decision is final
- Communication with the adjudicator or other interested parties is strictly forbidden and may be ground for disqualification
- The organizers reserve the right to modify or cancel the event should the lack of entries or other circumstances so warrant
- The organizers take no responsibility for any personal injury to any competitors, or loss or damage to the properties of any competitors, however caused or sustained
- Stamp given for Beginner Highland dances 1st, 2nd and 3rd places; for Novice and Intermediate in all dances 1st, 2nd and 3rd.
- Aggregate "Most Points" Trophy awarded in each age group over all dances, except Primary
- "Most Promising Beginner" Award, selected by the Adjudicator
- Perpetual Trophies to remain in Europe
- Dancers must be in full dancing outfit, including dance shoes, to receive awards
