GENERAL RULES – SATURDAY 11th APRIL 2020

1. This competition is registered with the South Queensland Regional Committee of Highland Dancing Inc. (Reg. No. SQC20/01) and will be conducted under the rules and conditions as set down by SOBHD and as adopted by ABHDI.
2. Dancers must be registered and present their registration card on the day of the competition.
3. Age to be taken as at the date of competition.
4. Pre-Premier - Eligibility for Pre-Premier sections will apply as at the date of competition and shall be in accordance with SOBHD Registration Scheme.
5. Dancers compete entirely at their own risk.
6. Dancers entering sections when ineligible shall forfeit their entry fee.
7. Competitors arriving late for a section will not be allowed to compete if that section has been completed.
8. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries, substitute a Judge and/or alter the programme at their discretion.
9. Subject to the official protest ruling, the Judge's decision is final.
10. Any complaint made by an individual against the Organisation or the adjudication of an event must be made in writing stating the complainant's full name and address and be lodged with the Organiser, if possible, on the day of the event, and not later than 48 hours after the event. The complaint must be accompanied by a fee of \$5.00, which is refundable if the protest is upheld.
11. For the presentation of prizes, dancers **MUST** be in Kilt or National Costume. Numbers must be worn for the prize-giving ceremony.
12. With the advent of electronic recording equipment there will be no restrictions on the usage of electronic recording equipment provided permission is obtained from the Organisers and Judges and it does not interfere with the smooth organisation of the Competition/Championship or in any way restrict the view of the Judge/s.
 - a. Following the awards parents may photograph their own child or others with parental permission but be highly aware that there must not be other children in shot whose privacy must be protected.
 - b. As Organisers of this event, we plan to photograph winning competitors for the purpose of posting on our Website or Facebook page. Please indicate if you wish to opt out of this process.
 - c. That Judges and Organisers should bear in mind that the Judge's decision is final and cannot be subjected to an electronic recording equipment replay.
13. No FLASH photography whilst the dancing is in progress.
14. If after submitting an entry a competitor changes in classification:
Prior to 28th February 2020 – please notify hdcomps on admin@hdcomps.com
On or after 28th February 2020 - please notify competition secretary on cocgc2020@hotmail.com
All changes must be finalised PRIOR to competition day.
15. **NO SMOKING** allowed in Competition Venue.
16. The ABHDI direct that dancers use dressing rooms to change costume, and to dress fully, appropriately and respectably when in public at competitions.

17. **ENTRIES CLOSE 28th FEBRUARY 2020.** No entries will be accepted after the closing date. A competitor who gains 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in any SOBHD/ABHDI registered Championship after the closing date of entries will be eligible to enter the Champion of Champions Championship of Australia. The Competitor must notify the Competition Secretary if he/she becomes eligible after the closing date.
18. All entries are to be submitted via hdcomps.com Email or telephone entries will not be accepted.
19. **Premier Trophy Dance:** This event is open to Premier Dancers who have been successful in gaining 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any registered Championship since 11th April 2017. Eligible dancers may also enter the Queensland Highland Dancing Championships.
20. **Premier (with Restriction) Trophy Dance and Section Dances:** These events are open to Premier Dancers who have not been successful in gaining 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a registered Championship since 11th April 2017. Dancers entering these events may also enter the Queensland Highland Dancing Championships.
21. Dancers must “fill in” if requested by the Organiser. If a competitor fails to fill in unless for a medical reason the Organiser has the right to enforce Rule 1g) D-Judges, SOBHD Rules and Regulations, which reads: “During the course of a competition the comportment and behaviour of the competitors may come under the jurisdiction of the Judges, not only whilst dancing, but also when entering or leaving the platform and whilst waiting for the dance to start. Any unseemly behaviour on the part of a competitor or any misdemeanour likely to upset the decorum of the proceedings may be penalised by the Judges and could lead to disqualification. A full report of any such conduct on the part of a competitor must be submitted by the Judge to the Organiser. In serious cases, the Judge should also provide a report of any such conduct on the part of the competitor to the Organiser and to the SOBHD.
22. Refunds: Entry fees are fully refundable prior to 28th February 2020. After 28th February 2020, refunds will only be given on production of a medical certificate and if the Competition Secretary is advised in writing prior to the event. No refunds will be given if a dancer does not meet the criteria above or does not compete on the day.

Qualification for this Special Award as per SOBHD rule covering qualification by birth or by residency – competitor must qualify by birth or by having been resident in Australia for six months immediately prior to the event.

To allow overall winners to take home a Champion of Champions Championship of Australia Perpetual Trophy, Frank Cleves Trophy, OzScot Australia Perpetual Trophy and Julie Appleton-Seymour Memorial Trophy, a refundable bond of \$100.00 will be charged, such bond refundable upon the Perpetual Trophy being returned in the same condition in which it was received.
